This is a one-day activity - lodging and transportation **ON YOUR OWN**.



Getting to Chickahominy Campground:

Take Main Street from downtown Richmond East past Rockett's Landing and past the entrance to the Capitol Trail. Continue on Route 5 east for approximately 45 miles. Chickahominy Campground is on the left after the bridge that crosses the Chickahominy River (J. S. Dresser Bridge).

Meet at Chickahominy Campground: Turn into the Campground Parking lot near the pool. Look for the RSC sign in the parking lot area by 10:30 AM.

What to Expect:

Meet us at 10:30 AM for a leisurely and moderately challenging group ride on one of the nicest sections of the Capitol Trail. The trail is mainly flat. We will ride approximately 8.5 miles east to Jamestown where you can stop and spend the afternoon, catch a ride on the free and historical Scotland Ferry or continue on with the group that rides on to the Williamsburg Winery (about 5 more miles east). The group will ride back to the campground at around 3 pm.

In the event of RAIN, this ride will be CANCELLED!
